- ➤ Motivation letter in which you state the reasons why you want to study abroad.
- Letter of presentation issued by the university of origin.
- ▶ Transcript of grades issued by the university of origin.
- Spanish proficiency certificate: validation of the Spanish language, only non-Spanish speaking students.
- ➤ Medical insurance: The student must have international medical insurance that covers the repatriation and medical expenses clause of COVID-19 for the duration of his/her/their stay.
- Visa or Permit to Stay: The student should contact the Mexican Consulate for more information:
